4. PROJECT GOAL, OBJECTIVES

Goal of the proposal:

Improvement in the livelihoods of poor through sustainable management of natural and other resources.

Objectives:

- To build and strengthen the capacities of SHGs, SHG Federation, Village Watershed Committees (VWC) and Central Coordination Committee (CCC) for stabilization of their functioning.
- To undertake rigorous campaign for utilizing the benefits of NREGA (National Rural Employment Guarantee Act) by the small and marginal farmers to improve their livelihoods by adopting sustainable soil, water and agricultural practices.
- To supplement the family income of the poor and marginalized stakeholders through Income Generation Activities (IGA).
- To demonstrate sustainable solid waste management processes in the project villages with partnership between Gram panchayats and the families.

Sub Objectives:

- 96 SHGs will have the capacity to conduct their meetings independently.
- 96 SHGs will have the capacity to maintain their books and documents independently.
- 237 families of landless poor and small farmers under the supervision of 10 Village Watershed Committees will have availed facilities under MGNREGA for improvement of their land, water, agriculture and basic amenities (2013-14).
- Families, landless in particular and others in general, will have started the processes of availing facilities under various government schemes and programme.
- Office bearers of Spandana SHG Federation will have gained knowledge of accounting and record maintaining.
- Spanadana SHG Federation will have gained institutional frame work for independent functioning.
- Spandana SHG Federation will have created awareness on women issues.

The work has been done under four objectives

Objective 1: To Build and strengthen the capacities of SHGs, SHG Federation, Village Watershed Committees and Central Coordination committee for Stabilization of their functioning

Under this objective we planned and implemented 8 activities:

- ❖ **Training for SHGs on conducting effective meetings:** 5 New SHGs formed. Disha Staff visited and attended 463 Meetings conducted by the 109 SHGs. 06 Groups members have written their grievances to government offices. 16 members Contested in Gramapanchayath Election and 08 members Elected.
- ❖ **Training for SHGs on maintaining books and documents** Yearly Audit has been conducted.
- ❖ **Village Watershed Committee meetings:** 20 village watershed committee (V.W.C) meetings held and discussed issue like MGNREGA, formation of coconut growers association, government schemes etc. Totally 30 works done and received Rs1,65,273.(one lakh sixty five thousand two hundred seventy three only.) They also conducted organizational meetings like annual meetings and election of new office bearers.The credit of success in MGNREGA works goes to vigilant Village Watershed Committees. They have raised issues with concern officials in various panchayath meetings.
- ❖ **Ward level contact meetings:** Ward level contact meetings were held in Kilinjar, Kolavoor, Muthur, Kandavara, Kolambe, Paduperara, Addur, Muloor, Mallur, and Moodushedde. Survey on village problems has been conducted in ten wads. 34 personal issues and 118 public issues has been enlisted and brought to the notice of panchayaths. Specifically 13 people applied for Rajivagandhi Housing schemes, 2 people applied for Toilet scheme and one person applied for sandya suraksha (old age pension) scheme.
- ❖ **Spandana okkuta executive committee trainings:** 05 one day duration trainings conducted for executive committee members of spandana federation on account and record keeping. Federation has elected new office bearers.
- ❖ **Developing organization structure for Spandana SHG federation:** During this reporting period Spandana federation has conducted 12 meetings.In these meetings, functions of the federation like collection of loan instalments, issuing of new loans to the needy SHGs etc are conducted. Conducted yearly election for office bearers. The committee is preparing bylaws and framing rules and regulations for its smooth functioning. Federation supported to SHGs financial in 9% Interest. Fedration extended loan facility for 20 months duration.earlier it was for 10 months only. Now the SHGs can borrow higher amount upto Rs 50,000/-. This year 29 SHGs borrowed Rs 8,70,000.from federation fund. The federation gave Rs 11700 Scholarship to 39 eligible Students.Federation also collected Rs 4,90,000 as share shares capital and distributed 10% divedend to the share holders
- ❖ **Sensitization of Spandana Federation members on women issues:** 12 issues related to women were discussed. These are on child education, health, pension schemes, Prevention of atrocities on women etc. An eye testing camp was organized at Badaga bellur. 84 persons attended and checked for eye sight defects or ailments. 03 homeopathic medical camps were held.

- ❖ **Dialogue with functionaries of financial and government institutions on EDP:** We conducted 4 dialogue meetings. 316 persons have applied for various government schemes. From the Building and other Construction workers welfare board 05 persons have obtained Identification (I.D) Cards and 01 family has applied for death claim. 5 person applied for marriage expense refund and 3 person received Rs 1,50,000/- . 62 members applied for scholarship. Previous year 14 members applied and 9 members received scholarship of Rs 31,000/-. 12 persons enrolled under NPS(National Pension Scheme). 16 persons enrolled Sukanya suraksha yojana (Girl child protection savings scheme), 36 persons enrolled for Pradanamanthri Jeevana jyothi Bima Yojana (Prime ministers insurance for death before 50 years of age) scheme, 114 persons enrolled for Pradanamanthri Suraksha bima Yojana (Insurance for accidental death upto 70 years of age), 44 persons opened new Jandhan savings (Zero balance account for bringing poor people under banking and loan facilities.) Account at bank. 21 persons applied for minorities department self employment schemes and 8 members received Rs 2,00,000/- as subsidised loan
- ❖ **Institutionalization of Central Coordination Committee (CCC).** It is also called Nesara Kendria Samanvaya Samithi.(NKSS): 04 meetings, One Seed exhibition and distribution program, one Farmers exposure visit conducted. The Central Committee is conducting its meeting once in three months. It has focused its attention on drinking water and other ward level issues, awareness on NRM, on school children; MGNREGA etc. This year Best farmer award is given to 10 farmers. The Award money Rs 5000/- was donated by a well wisher in commemoration of his father's death anniversary.

Objective 2: To undertake rigorous campaign for utilizing the benefits of NREGA (National Rural Employment Guarantee Act) by the small and marginal farmers to improve their livelihoods by adopting sustainable soil, water and agricultural practices.

Under this objective we have planned and implemented 03 activities:

- ❖ **Awareness programme on MGNREGA:** Motivated farmers in MGNREGA, 29 farmers applied to the line to carry out a variety of projects in year 2016.
- ❖ **Dialogue meetings with Government officials:** In this reporting period 11 dialogue meetings with government officials have been conducted. 300 persons were present for these meetings. DISHA staff, panchayath president, Panchayath PDO, MGNREGA Social audit Taluk Coordinator Mr. Rajeev Salian were present. These meetings are mandatory. DISHA staff and members of village watershed committee utilized the forum to vocalize their grievance. Hence these meetings were useful in getting payments on MGNREGA works. 30 people started MGNREGA Work in this reporting period. 02 person Started construction of cowshed, 17 persons Started Construction work of drinking water well, One Person began construction of goat rearing shed, 4 person Planted areca plants, 2 person planted pepper plants, 4 person started house construction work. This year a total amount Rs 1, 65,273/- paid for the workers of above mentioned activities under MGNREGA in this year.
- ❖ **Information dissemination program on MGNREGA through Publicity material:** In this year conducted 11 Dialogue meetings with govt officials on MGNREGA. The publicity has helped us very much to disseminate information among farmers and citizens of the village.

Objective 3. To supplement the family income of the poor and marginalized stakeholders through Income Generation Activities (IGA).

Under this objective we planned and implemented 02 activities:

- ❖ **Enterprise development training:** 04 enterprise development training conducted. 118 members participated. 12 persons have availed loan facility from revolving fund (DISHA IGP fund). These self employed are doing self employment. The staff are assessing their enterprises. Till last reporting period 67 persons availed loan facility. Now the total people involved in revolving fund are 79.
- ❖ **Enterprise development motivation training for those who start new:** 05 motivation training. 150 persons participated. We have concentrated our efforts on those who have availed loan for self employment. The motivational training focused on improving existing skills, Increase income by hard work, improve the quality of existing enterprise.

Objective 4. To demonstrate sustainable solid waste management processes in the project villages with partnership between Gram panchayats and the families.

- ❖ The initiatives started on collection of disposable plastics is continuing. Keeping collection bags in their homes is continued. The SHG members kept all the plastic bags in their home made containers. Presently the clean plastics are gathered once in three months and delivered to a recycling unit. Dialogue with panchayath is going on evolving proper disposal methods.
- ❖ Discussion meetings have been held with Zilla Panchayath and panchayaths of Gurupura, Kandavara and Paduperara
- ❖ On 15-10-2015, Disha and Paduperara panchayath jointly conducted pipe compost demonstration at kanthanagara, kathalsara, Gurukambala disha coordinator Mr Henry valder and Sylvester D Souza guided.

7. Whether the present project has contributed to any other development activities in the target area during the reporting period (either activities by the target group and/or the community as a whole)

Impact of the project as a whole:

- ✓ In this reporting period we have stressed the need of building confidence in them and continue to operate SHGs. The SHGs, VWC, CCC (Village watershed committees, federation and Central coordination committees) are fairly doing well. The meetings are conducted by themselves. DISHA staff oversees the operations. They look up for guidance and interventions during difficult situations like untimely loan repayments, non attendance by some members for crucial meetings etc.
- ✓ The various committees formed during the previous phase are functioning and the members are supervising works executed in the previous phase. The committee members also represented the issue with panchayaths about the problem of non payment of wages to the MGNREGA beneficiaries.

- ✓ We had a Seed festival on 5th of June 2015 on memory of Mr Thyampanna Shetty. The Family donated Rs 5000/- for awarding most improved farmer under DISHA's farming fraternity. The Central committee awarded the amount to 10 small farmers who have put much of their efforts in improving their agriculture.

8. Problems/Risks and ways /means of tackling the same

- ✓ The consolidation phase helped us to increase rapport and proximity to panchayaths. In this reporting period, New representatives for panchayath body has been elected. We have the task of familiarizing with new activities of panchayaths. The new panchayath members have pledged their support for peoples actions. Mean while two panchayaths have split in to two each. Now in future instead of 5, there will be 7 panchayaths under our area of operation.
- ✓ Discussion on scientific waste disposal programme is going on. Committee members are participating in the discussions. We hope some solution will be found.

9. Short description of the monitoring and evaluation system applied (flow of information and decision taking processes, involvement of target group and other stake holders.)

- ✓ The project was initiated by people. Now they know very well the whole process from where they have begun. The awareness programme, formation of SHGs, formation of various committees, implementation of various activities, utilization of support grants, the contributions etc are the main programmes of the project. They have created a fund to run meetings of the central committee as well. The federation and central committee accounts are maintained by themselves. Before taking any decisions, the respective bodies discuss it in their regular meetings. Activities which are taken up in the previous phase are also discussed in their regular meetings.

I could make a Living- Lilly Cutinha



My name is Lilly Cutinha, I am 65 years old. I live with my son and daughter in law. My home is in Kandavara village. My husband expired long back. I have 6 children. 5 boys and one girl. My last son lives with me. Others have built their own houses. I am a member of Thryodashi SHG. It is promoted by DISHA trust. Our SHG has total 12 members. We meet once in 15 days. We save Rs 100 every month. We got training from DISHA on how to conduct meetings and how to maintain books etc. I participated in various programmes which exposed me to the

external life. We also participate in village committee meetings, central committee meetings. We conducted annual get together in which members of all SHGs met and exchanged our views. Being a SHG member I personally benefitted. I built stone wall, repaired drinking water well, constructed biogas unit. A vented dam was built in our village. The dam is maintained by a committee. The dam has increased ground water level in the area. There are 14 open wells and 12 borewells in the area. I too have a bore well in which water is improved. My self confidence has improved after joining the SHG. There is community feeling in our group. We help each other in our group.

I grow paddy on quarter acre and vegetable for my living. I also grow paddy on one acre land by giving rent to the land owner. I have applied under MGNREGA for planting areca plants. Panchayath has paid me Rs 13320 as wages for my work. I rear 3 cows and sell 3 litres milk daily. Other benefit from dairy is the manure which I use for growing vegetables. I also work as agricultural labourer. Thus I make a living.

I learnt Tailoring.-Harinakshi.

My name is Harinakshi. I am resident of Kalavoor, Muthoor Panchayath, Mangalore Taluk Dakshina Kannada. I studied upto S.S.L.C. I gave up study because my parents were unable to meet my school fees. My father expired when I was small. Now I am 26 years old. I am living with my mother and brother. My father built the house. The house is very old. We have 0.07 acre land. We grow vegetable for our home consumption. I learnt Tailoring. I borrowed a loan from revolving fund of DISHA trust and purchased a sewing machine. Now I do tailoring work along with beedi rolling. I am still studying tailoring. My elder brother learnt carpentry work.



He is earning livelihood from carpentry work. He was alcoholic. Our SHG members persuaded him to give up drinking. Now from the last one year he has stopped drinking. He takes certain responsibilities of home.



doing well.

In our SHG there are 12 members. we save Rs 80 per month. We meet once in a week. Apart from savings we help each other in their need. I joined the SHG on 11-12-2009. After joining SHG I improved my personality. I was shy and never used to mix with others. Extreme poverty at home is a humiliating factor. After I joined the SHG I found there many people worse than me. Each one in the SHG has a story to tell. Now I participate in the meeting. SHG gave me the responsibility of secretary which I am

My confidence has improved:Rukiya Banu,

My name is Rukiya Banu.I born in Addoor.My father is Mumba Byari and mother Sefia.We are 7 children to our parents. I have not gone to school. I learnt beedi rolling. When I was 17, my parents married me to daily wage worker namly Abdul Aziz. In marriage I got 9 children. Now five of my children have married and are settled. Our village doesnot have proper streets, drinking water and other basic neccessities. I was vocal at panchayaths.My neighbours supported me to contest panchayath elections. I was elected to panchayath.After I elected to panchayath, I spoke benefits to be given to the poor and needy which are



meant for the them. My self confidence improved after I joined SHG promoted by DISHA trust for which I am grateful.Presently I am elected as president of Gurpur panchayath.After becoming president of the panchayath my responsibility towards all the citizens of my village has increased. I go to the panchayath every day. I am now 53 year old.I pray God to give me strength to do justice to the poor and needy of the village and also to give courage to stand by justice.I wish all people of the community live in hormony and peace

We formed SHG,We progressed:

Name of our SHG is Mangala Farmers group Mallur,Ulaibettu panchayath. Our SHG formed on 5-04-2009.

There are 20 members in our SHG.We meet once a month. we save Rs 100 per month. As on 31-12-2015 our savings are Rs 116500. We provide internal loan to our members.Our borrowers are prompt in repaying the loans.After forming the SHG our self confidence has improved.We are all small and marginal farmers having less than 5 acres of land. We grow paddy,vegetables,coconuts. Some our members also grow areca crop.The areca crop(beetal nuts) has commercial value and they get some extra income which will be used to maintain their families. Our members also rear milch animals. They do labour



work also. We were not aware of the panchayath programmes.After becoming members to the SHG, DISHA trust guided us in organising contact meetings with government officials, writing applications to various schemes etc. Before forming our group we were not participating in the panchayath meetings because the panchayath did not care us and not responding to any of our grievences. But after becoming members of SHG and also affiliating to various committees formed by DISHA, our confidence level is improved.We started again to attend panchayath meetings.Since we are bit organised, we are able to press for our demands. Other members also supported for the cause. We did not get MGNREGA job cards, work sanction orders etc. But DISHA trust taught us how to write applications, whom to approach if our works did not get through etc.We submitted our applications according to guidelines. We also kept a duplicate copy of each application submitted to panchayath.This practice helped us to follow each of our case. Panchayaths could not escape from our follow ups.They obliged and complied to our needs.Under MGNREGA programme, three persons got job work to plant areca plants,5 persons for pepper,one person for vermi compost unit,two persons for stone bunding. Apart from MGNREGA,our road has been repaired,street lights have been installed.still there

are two MGNREGA works are pending for payments, Now we know the importance of forming and managing our SHG.

11. Summarized appraisal and self-assessment (regarding the reporting period and the further project implementation)

- ✓ In this reporting period, the members of SHGs and all other committees understood the importance of coming together and ascertaining rights and claiming legitimate benefits especially with panchayaths and departments. The departments are responding to the needs of the members of SHGs and farmers. But, the actions are much slow. Despite representations some of the works are not carried out. The committee members have to represent the case with higher officials. It happens frequently with MGNREGA works. The housing schemes seldom takes off. Distribution of house sites for the needy are pending for many years. Our SHG members raised these issues in the Grama Sabha. The persuasion is going on.
- ✓ The SHGs and committee members are learning to represent the issues with government officials. Follow up is needed. Members are learning to do it.
